



FIXED WINDOW

Designed to remain stationary and does not open or close. Oftentimes found in shapes like arch, half-moon, triangle, etc.



HORIZONTAL ROLLER

One or more sashes (movable glass panels) slide horizontally along a track.



CASEMENT WINDOW

Hinged on one side and swings outward, similar to a door, or upward, like an awning.



SINGLE HUNG WINDOW

Bottom sash (movable panel) slides vertically, while the top sash remains fixed.




FRENCH DOOR

Single or double doors with glass panes extending along most of its surface.



PIVOT DOOR

Operates on a pivot hinge, allowing it to rotate on a central or offset axis rather than swinging on side hinges like traditional doors



SLIDING DOOR

Two or more panels which slide horizontally along a track to open and close. Available in multiple panel options with various opening configurations.

BI-FOLD PATIO DOOR

Two or more panels panels connected by hinges that fold and slide along a track to stack neatly against one side (or both sides) of the opening.
